COURSE OUTLINE - LEVEL 2 CREATIVE HAIR AND BEAUTY STUDIES CERTIFICATES (3004)

Currently Unity College is in the process of constructing brand new salon facilities which will give students the opportunity to experience a highly professional working environment. The course we are offering is Level 2 Creative Hair and Beauty Studies Certificate (3004)

The Level 2 Creative Hair and Beauty Studies Certificate is an excellent pathway for learners looking for a career in Hair or Beauty or a combined Hair and Beauty career. The qualification will allow learners to develop their creative skills and gain a valuable underpinning knowledge of the industry. The course provides an awareness of the range of jobs and work settings available within the industry and will help the learner to make informed decisions about careers in the sector.

During the course learners will study the following modules:-

- The Art of Photographic Make Up
- The Art of Dressing Hair
- The Art of Colouring Hair
- Head Massage
- Body Art

Each unit comprises of both theory and practical study. There are also optional units including Skin Tanning and Facial Skin Care.

The Certificate in Creative Hair and Beauty Studies is a two year course and learners will attend approximately 3 lessons per week.

The qualification provides a solid progression route for those learners wishing to enrol onto NVQ Level 2 Hair and Beauty or for those who choose to pursue an apprenticeship within the industry.

COURSE OUTLINE CONSTRUCTION – EDEXCEL BTEC LEVEL 1/LEVEL 2 FIRST AWARD IN CONSTRUCTION AND THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT

What is this qualification worth?

The Level 1 qualification is graded at a Pass.

The Level 2 qualification is graded at Pass, Merit, Distinction or Distinction*.

What will you learn?

To achieve the Level 1/2 in Construction you must achieve 3 theory units which include written exams and assignments and various practical units. Assessment process will include 25% external and 75% internal assessments.

These qualifications provide you with the opportunity to acquire useful personal skills, building up your individual confidence, as well as a broad introduction to the construction sector, by developing relevant practical skills and the associated knowledge and understanding required in this field of work.

Practical sessions will include 3 out of the following units; developing joinery skills, developing trowel skills, painting and decorating skills in plumbing and electrical areas of building services.

Theory sessions include the following topics; construction technology, construction and design and scientific and mathematical application for construction.

What happens when you have successfully completed your course?

Having achieved the course, it may be possible to further your personal development and employability by undertaking another qualification in a vocational area that interests you. Alternatively, you could progress to qualification in Construction and the Built Environment. Potential careers in Construction can be Architecture, Quantity Surveying, Building Controls and the skilled trade areas.

COURSE OUTLINE – MOTOR INDUSTRY IMIAL AWARD IN VEHICLE MAINTENANCE

This award provides an introduction to the motor vehicle industry. It provides a guided introduction to the technical needs of the motor repair and maintenance industry, including basic motor vehicle repair processes, principles and foundation skills. Students also gain a broad knowledge and understanding of health and safety in the workplace and other skills associated with working within the motor industry. The course provides a solid foundation in order to progress and develop higher level skills later on.
